The Pony Car

On April 17, 1964, the Ford Motor Company unveiled the Mustang at the New York World's Fair. Lee Iacocca, the Ford division



manager, received the design from design chief Joe Oros, who explained his idea, "I told the team that I wanted the car to appeal to women, but I wanted men to desire it, too...I said it should be as sporty as possible and look like it was related to European design."

What emerged is perhaps the best-known American sports car ever made, a vehicle that launched the "pony car" class of American muscle cars, including Chevrolet's Camaro and the Plymouth Barracuda. Only the Ford Mustang, though, spanned four decades of production and development, and became an icon of American automotive lore.

The first week it was offered, Ford sold 22,000 Mustangs, and eventually sold over one million cars in its first two years. This proved the most successful car launch in automotive history.

After forty years of redesign and redevelopment, 2004's Ford Mustang underwent major design changes and harkened back to the muscle car of the 1960s. And in 2009, Ford created a special Lee Iacocca Commemorative Edition Mustang, honoring the car's inventor as well as the Mustang's forty-five year run of production. The galloping pony symbol, Mustang's emblem, symbolizes the car that America fell in love with, and it looks as if the pony will gallop on at full speed into the future.
